<b>AP (Advanced Placement Testing Fees)</b>	\$93.00 per student per test	Student is responsible for the fees for the testing. If a student has free or reduced lunch, the College Board supplements the cost for the student.

The funds from the parking are used for the printing of the student handbooks, parking permit stickers, PBIS rewards, PBIS programs, Flags for the front of the building, food/snacks for Keystone Testing,
