NEW MEASURE FOR SCHOOL ACCOUNTABILITY



BACKGROUND

- NEW PERFORMANCE MEASURES CREATED TO ALIGN TO THE PENNSYLVANIA EVERY STUDENT SUCCEEDS ACT (ESSA).
- HOLISTIC TOOL THAT PROVIDES COMMUNITIES WITH A ONE-STOP LOCATION FOR COMPREHENSIVE INFORMATION AND DATA ON STUDENT AND SCHOOL SUCCESS.
- REPLACES THE FORMER SCHOOL PERFORMANCE PROFILE (SPP) SCORE THAT ONLY PROVIDES A SINGLE NUMBER TO REPRESENT PERFORMANCE.

DASHBOARD VS. SUMMATIVE SCORES

- DASHBOARD FORMAT (FUTURE READY) PRESENTS ACTUAL SCHOOL PERFORMANCE FOR EACH INDIVIDUAL INDICATOR WITHOUT COMPILING INTO A SINGLE SCORE
 - TREATS THE ACCOUNTABILITY SYSTEM AS A TOOL FOR CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT
 - MAXIMIZES TRANSPARENCY OF PERFORMANCE ON INDIVIDUAL MEASURES.
 - KEEPS DISSIMILAR MEASURES DISTINCT, AVOIDING ACCOUNTABILITY WEIGHTING ISSUES
- SUMMATIVE RATINGS (SPP) AGGREGATES VARIOUS MEASURES, THROUGH WEIGHTINGS, INTO A SINGLE SCORE.
 - PLACES VALUE ON INDICATORS IN THE ACCOUNTABILITY SYSTEM
 - HIGHER PERFORMANCE IN ONE AREA OFFSETS LOWER PERFORMANCE IN ANOTHER
 - MAY SUGGEST COMPARABILITY OR COMBINE DISSIMILAR MEASURES
 - OVERSIMPLIFIES SUBGROUP PERFORMANCE

 - MEETING ANNUAL GROWTH EXPECTATIONS (PVAAS)
 - PRECENT ADVANCED ON PSSA/KEYSTONE EXAM (FORMALLY BONUS POINTS ON SPP)
- ON-TRACK MEASURES
 - ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICENCY
 - CHRONIC ABSENTEEISM
 - GRADE 3 READING/GRADE 7 MATH EARLY INDICATORS OF SUCCESS
- COLLEGE AND CAREER MEASURES
 - GRADUATION RATE
 - CAREER STANDARDS BENCHMARK
 - INDUSTRY BASED LEARNING
 - POST-SECONDARY TRANSITION TO SCHOOL, MILITARY, OR WORK
 - RIGOROUS COURSES OF STUDY


